
WHAT LABELS ME?

- The handicap or disease I have





Christ set us free from the curse of the law. He did it by becoming a curse for us. It is written, "Everyone who is hung on a pole is under God's curse." Galatians 3:13 NIV

1. Identify Curses in Your Life

Ask the Holy Spirit to remind you of any negative words, labels, or hurtful remarks that have affected you

2. Declare The Curses As Lies

Pray a simple prayer, in Jesus' name, rejecting all harmful words spoken over you. Declare by the blood of Jesus you are set free to live in God's truth.

3. Give and Receive Forgiveness

Ask God to forgive you for believing lies and letting them steal life from you. Forgive anyone who has harmed or wronged you and bless them as God has blessed and forgiven you.

4. Renounce Spirits Behind the Curse

In the authority of Jesus name, command all disturbing spirits behind the curses to go. Reclaim your freedom in Christ.

5. Fill The Empty Place With Blessing

It is God's will that you live in blessing. Now is the time to declare the truth of God's word over yourself to make you creative and fruitful as God intends.
